The Forest Research Institute (FRI) is an institute of the Indian Council of Forestry Research and Education and is a premier institution in the field of forestry research in India. It is located at Dehradun in Uttarakhand. and is among the oldest institutions of its kind. In 1991, it was declared a deemed university by the University Grants Commission.

The Forest Research Institute campus hosts the Indira Gandhi National Forest Academy (IGNFA), the staff college that trains officers selected for the Indian Forest Service (IFS).

The Forest Research Institute has a great scenic beauty and it attracts thousands of tourists towards its Punch Beat, Rehna hai tere dil mein etc and many more. This

FRI also has museums which has a nominal ticket of about Rs.40/-only. It opens from 9.30 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. daily. There are six sections of museums present in FRI which are Pathology, Entomology, Timber, Silviculture, Social Forestry, Non-

Wood Production. FRI conducts its own entrance exams for forestry related subjects and the candidate needs to pass the entrance exam and the counselling even.

The more we get to know about FRI we get more and more subjects about it. FRI is a great example of beauty with brain as it not only has beautiful scenario and infrastructure but also has a good level of education. FRI is a great tourist spot in which many foreigners even come to visit from around the world.



Colleges to get into the next semester.








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SECOND HOME FOR THEM, HOSTEL GIRLS SAID...

OLD AGE HOMES IN INDIA....

The number of old age home is growing rapidly day by day in India. Rich or poor everyone is found thrown away by their children in the old age homes. India comes in the top list

where the old age home is growing at a rapid stage.

Through a survey by a NGO in India it is found that there are 728 Old Age Homes in India today. Detailed information of 547 homes is available. Out of these. 325 homes are free of cost while 95 old age homes are on pay & stay basis, 116 homes have both free as well as pay & stay facilities and 11 homes have no information. A total of 278 old age homes all over the country are available for the sick and 101 homes are exclusively for women. Kerala has 124 old age homes which is maximum in any state.

The country where people treat parents as god also have children's who torture their old parents. They make their parents do physical labour as well. Visiting an old age home is seeing angels and fairies without wings and their wings are those unworthy children who left their hands when they needed to hold it the most.
