The topics of the extempore were Topics of the Extempore.


Digital payments are secure and India is ready to go 100% cashless, Chinese goods are a threat to Indian businessmen and economy, India needs bullet trains, Corona


This is a great way by which students can be the helping hands to the needy. A life served for others is the best way to contribute to live in this world.

DBS TAKES STRICT MEASURES FOR THE STUDENTS AGAINST CORONA

Doon Business School which is located in Selaqui, Dehradun has been closed due to the Corona Virus pandemic in the country. College didn't think of anything else before its students who were needed to be rescued as soon as possible and sent back to their homes before this Covid-19 cases counts more in the country. Tie students were asked to book their tickets and leave the college premises by 18th march, 2020. It was a strict action taken by the college authorities so that students would get a proper and better care in their hometown or home itself with their families

Students even took this

seriously call and booked their tickets way back to home. The college authorities decided to give online classes to the students as their syllabus should not be pending because the situation and it was even the government's decision that the schools and colleges will be remaining close but shall continue with their online classes.

Students were asked to take the out pass from their respective hostel wardens and make a call to their parents infront of the warden so as to make a check the students are going back to their homes and they have informed about the sudden suspension of classes in the college premises.

In view of the prevailing and developing situation arising out of COVID-19, DBS has had several meetings with the stakeholders and has taken the following decisions for the safety of all for the next two weeks (i.e. from 16 March to 29 March). Further plan of action would he communicated to all by 27th March. All students were required to have their systems up and running and have access to ERP/ Moodle and have Zoom installed on their laptop.

Students who are staying in hostel have the option of staying or going to their hometown. The maximum duration allowed to stay in the hostel is till Tuesday (17 March) end of day. If any student wishes to stay in the hostel beyond that period, that student would have to provide an undertaking from parents that they are aware of the decision of the student and support the same. Basic facilities would be provided in the hostel for the duration of the stay. Please note that as all classes/ tests would be online in the week thereafter, there would be no class/ test in the campus.

As this is an exceptional situation, and there is no previous history, please keep yourself updated as to the safety measures being recommended and inform the authorities in

case you find any symptoms, whether in yourself or any of your colleagues. Your co-operation is essential for us to fight the situation together and ensure the well-being of all of us.

Further, necessary steps would be taken as appropriate and instructions would be shared with you by the Program/ Class coordinators and other DBS functionaries as and when the need arises. Please get in touch with your Program/ Class coordinators in case you require any clarification.

Though there is a lot of sadness among the students as it was a time for them to show case their talents but as the country is fighting against such a situations little sacrifices are much needed right


now.

Coronaviruses are a large family of viruses. Some coronaviruses cause cold-like illnesses in people, while others cause illness in certain types of animals, such as cattle, camels, and bats.

Some coronaviruses, such as canine and feline coronaviruses, only infect animals and do not infect humans. Some cause illness in people and others cause illness in certain types of animals. Coronaviruses that infect animals can become able to infect people, but this is rare. It is unknown the exact source of the current outbreak of coronavirus disease 2019 (3COVID-19).

In January and February, industrial output fell by 13.5% from the same period a year earlier, the weakest reading since January 1990 — when Reuters' record began Retail sales in January and February shrank 20.5%

from a year ago, compared with a 8% growth in December as fearful consumers avoided crowded places like malls, restaurants and cinemas. The economy in China came to a standstill starting in late January as the government locked down cities and implemented quarantines to contain the spread of the coronavirus disease, formally known as COVID-19. Colleges in India are being shut down, all the schools and colleges have been closed due to the covid-19 spreading in India. 
